After being offered a biscuit stamp on her birthday, this young Aixoise cookie maker discovered that this is no way to personalise her biscuits. With a pastry roller, a cookie cutter, and a recipe of her own, she decided to trust her instincts and to offer the public what she knew best: personalised biscuits on which people could give little messages. She showed off the cookies on her Instagram account and the adventure began to the run, so much so that she was quickly overwhelmed in her little apartment. Today Shanty Baehrel has tripled the growth of her brand of customisable cookies which she created in 2013. It needs to expand its production site, moving in October, and will test its first pop-up shop this year. There are now close to 12 people with her to get the message across. We would write "love is in the air" on our biscuit!

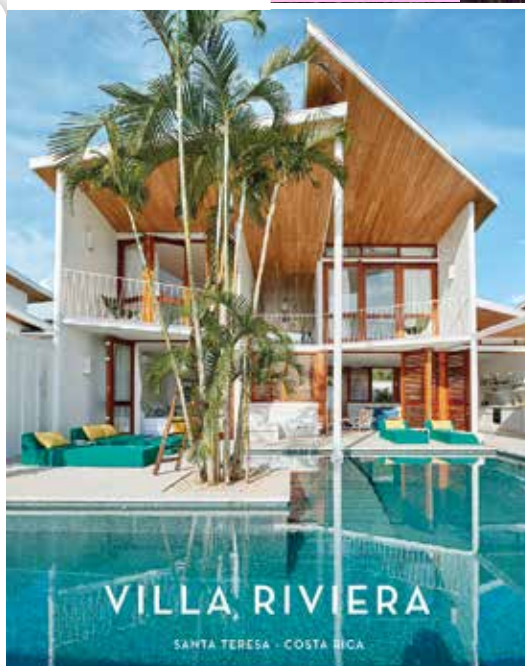
